Our community wall has been growing! We can't wait to see how big it gets! Can you find your name on the wall?

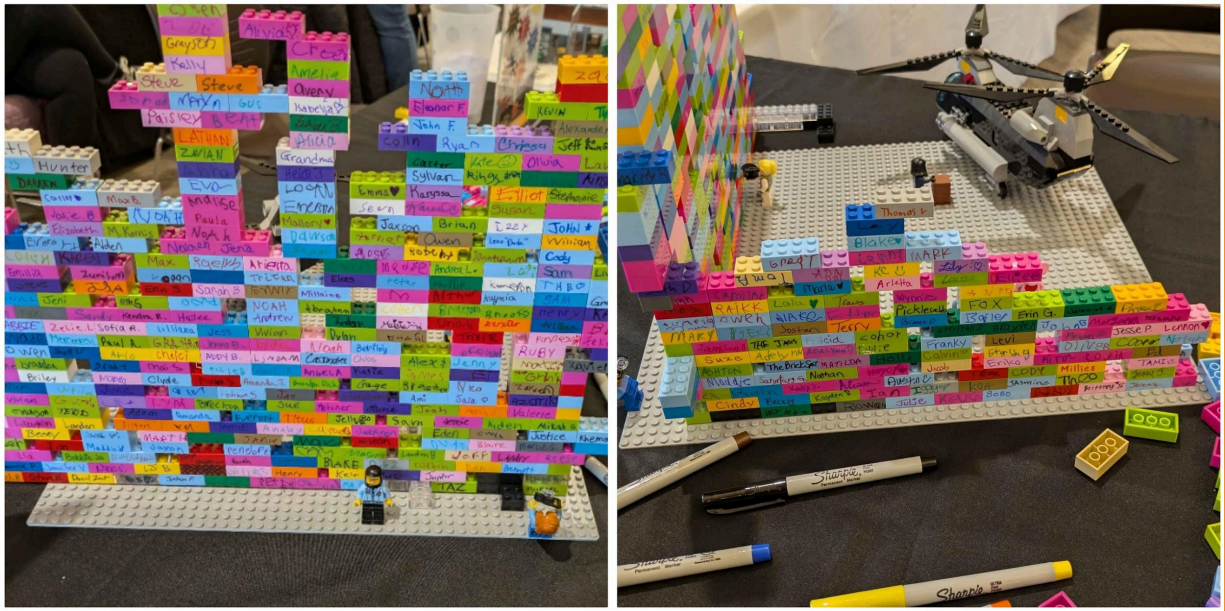

KFOL - Kid Fan Of Lego

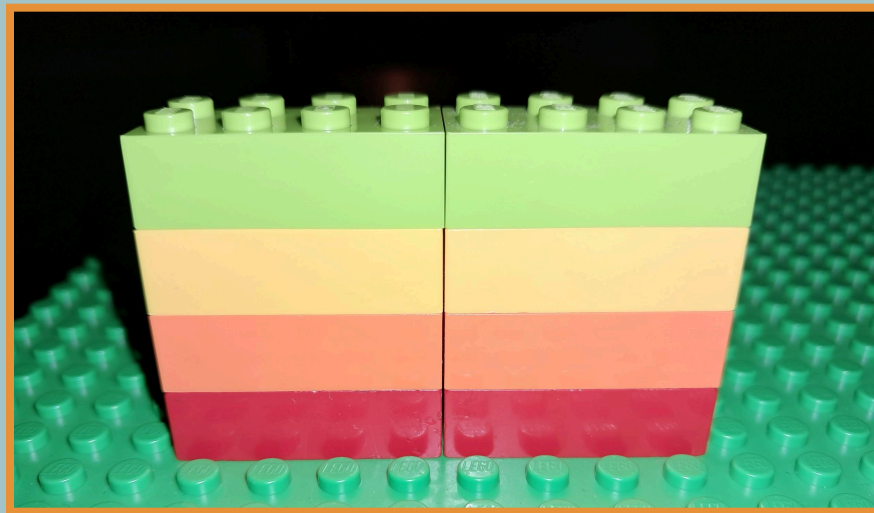
Kids who like to build with Lego are called KFOLs.

Kit's Building Technique

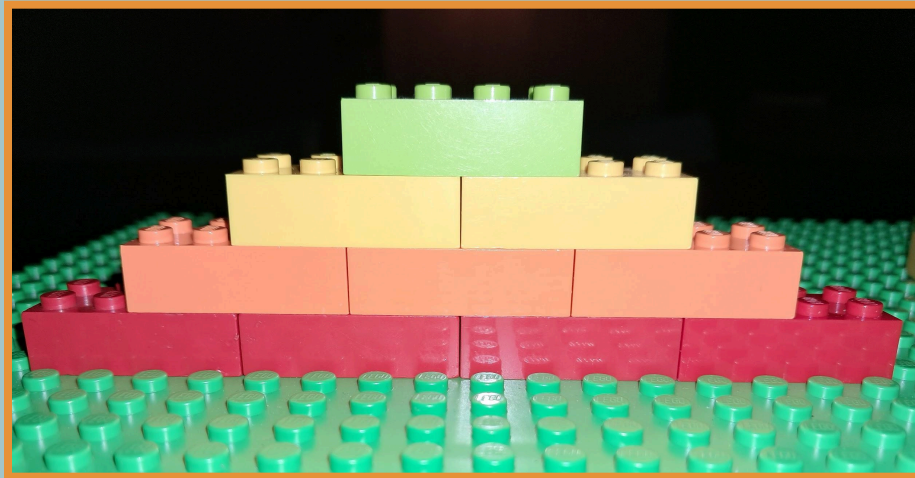
Building Strong Walls

When you build a wall, you want to place your bricks to look like steps, also called staggering, to make the wall stronger.

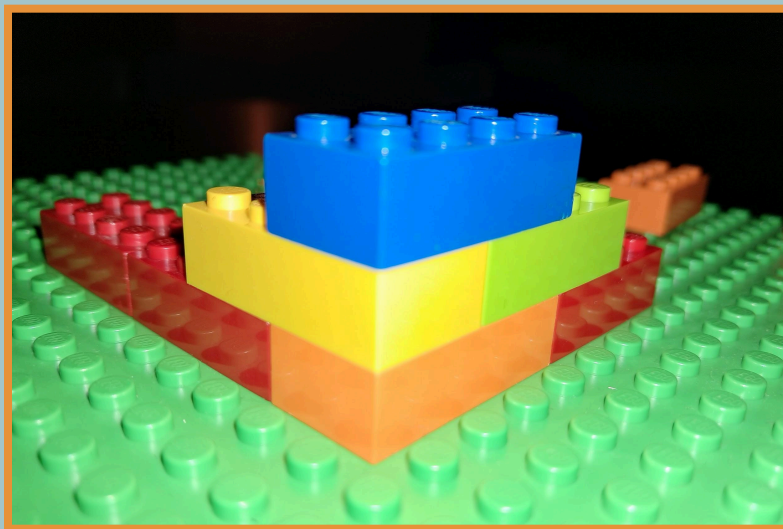
If you place your bricks on top of each other without staggering them, your wall is going to be very weak and can easily be knocked over.



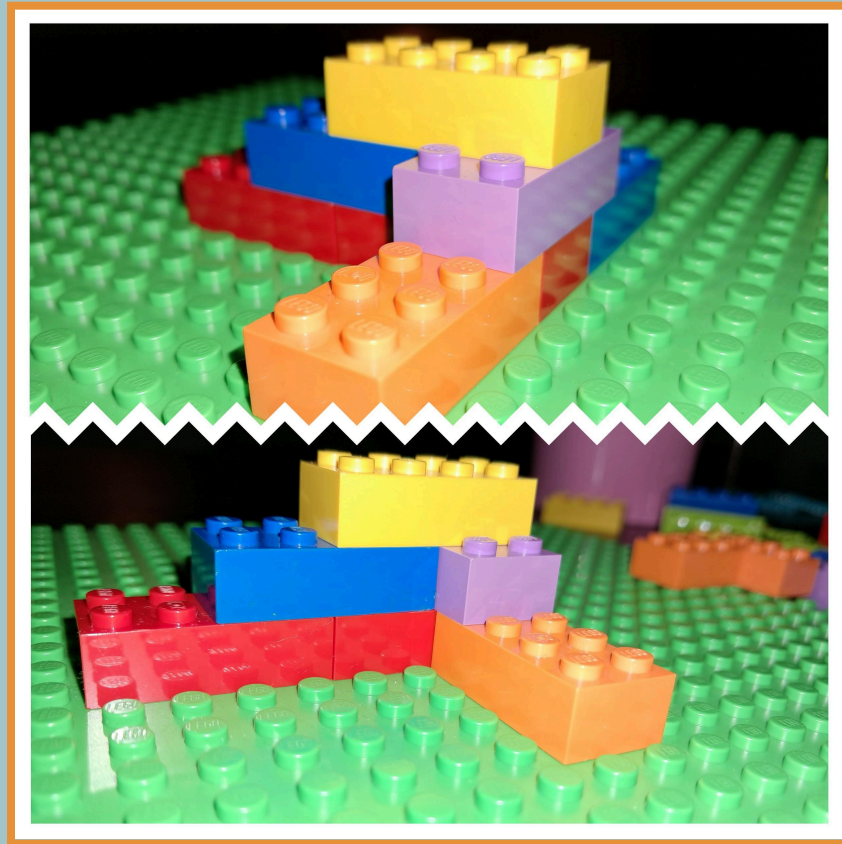
But if you stagger your bricks, like steps, it will be much stronger.



You should also use this technique when you build two walls that join together.



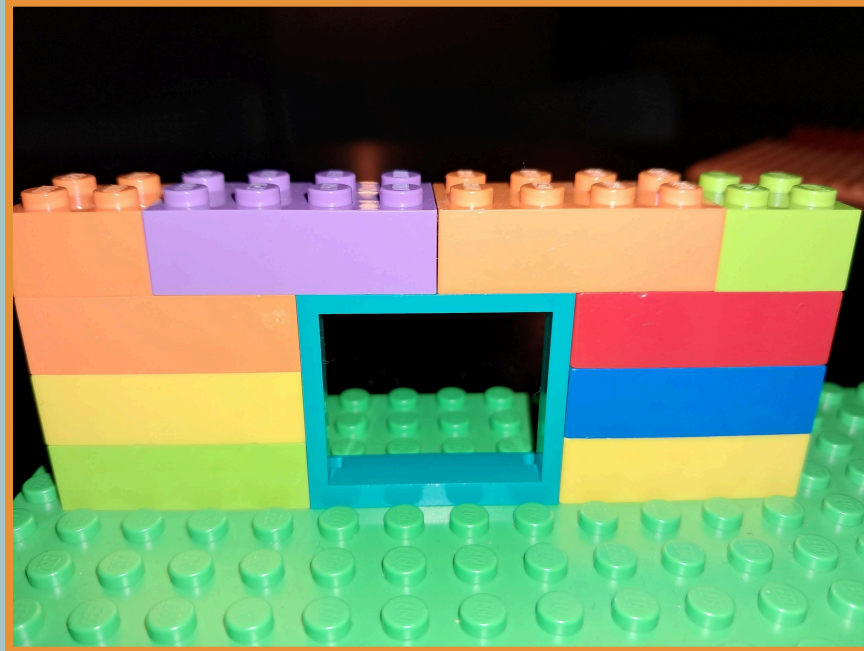
You can even use it to build walls inside of your building by staggering bricks.



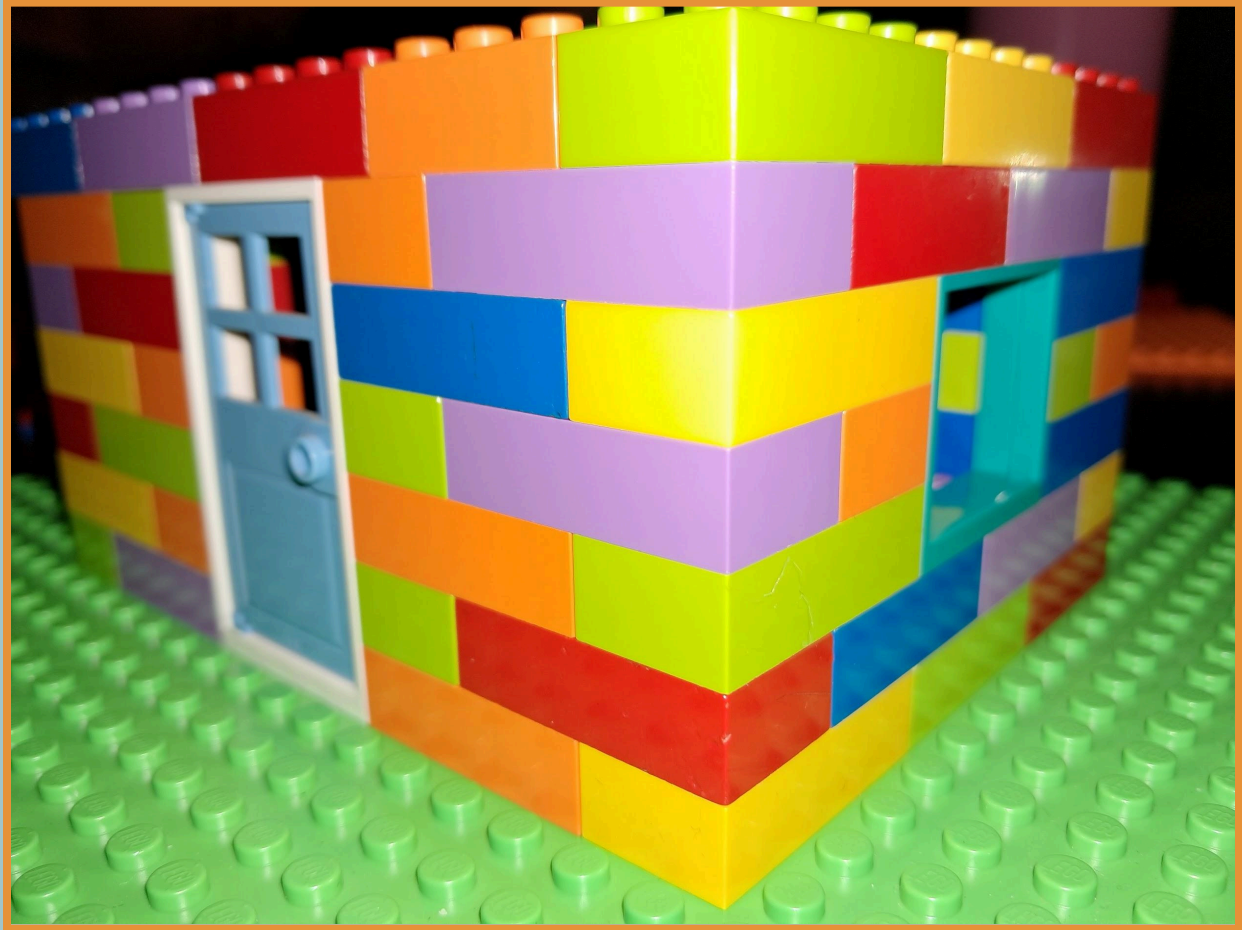
This technique can be used with windows and doors too.



Sometimes when you're using a window or door you can't stagger them or you might not have the right bricks, so just make sure that you stagger them when you can, like the top of this window.



And your building is complete!

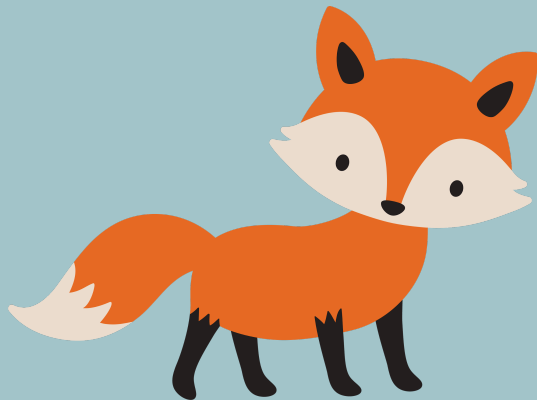
